- Contact with your Erasmus+ Coordinator to prepare paperwork
- Sign Learning Agreement for Traineeship
- Travel for internship and make this opportunity as a chance of a lifetime!

Chosen your direction already? Check all details and make sure to sign online learning agreement (OLA) which includes all important details of your faculty of study, ECTS points.

Remember! Once signed and accepted OLA can't be changed!

OLA is a key standard document for each student which guarantees academic recognition and allows to transfer ECTS points obtained abroad to your University.

Foreign language study department at SGSP

Starting education at SGSP both cadet and civil students have an unique possibility to continue specialist language learning and from other selected languages in their field of study.

Foreign language study department has a huge course offer from specialist language which is so important on a labour market.

Our lectors are preparing students before travelling for Erasmus+ programees.

For SGSP's workers:

Whom can be the beneficiary of the programme?

A beneficiary of the Erasmus+ programme can be each of the SGSP's workers. Didactics worker can travel to partners University in order to prepare lecture, administrative workers can travel to gain practise and experience.

What is the amount of the scholarship for realization of the mobility as a part of Erasmus+ programme?

Amount of the scholarship is dependable on the lenght of stay in partners University, hosting country and the amount of the fundings which university received for this goal.

In general are realized about 5 days long visits, for which the value of the scholarship is about 600 – 800€. Additionally there is a possibility to acheive co-fundings to cover cost of the journey from Univeristies budget.

Internships for Alumni's

In Erasmus+ program for international internship can travel also SGSP's alumni's but the travel has to end no later then 1 year after graudation under condition of taking part in Erasmus+ recruitment proces during studies and fulfilling all conditions descibed in Rector-Commandant regulations No. 16/2021 from 30th March 2021. According to rules of delegations for abroad of students whom aren't firefighters of the Main School of Fire Serivce for scientific and training in Erasmus+ program.

Lenght of internship is included for total lenght of time mobility on studies level, on which student was qualified for travel.

For academic workers and lecturers

The main goal for administrative worker is to participate in workshops which will improve qualifications with the character of work done in alma mater, improving work competences and expanding knowledge in dedicated area, participating in trainings and so called: „work shadowing” etc.

Workers have to know language of visiting country of internship on a good level.

Standard length of the training lasts of 1 working week. Training can take between 2-5 days from working week (EU programs) and 5 in case of travel to so called: partnership countries.

Outgoing lecturer is obligated to held at least 8 lecture hours during week and any shorter time.

During qualification for international travel in Erasmus+ programme additionally pointed are:

- those whom haven't traveled with Erasmus+ yet
- full-time workers of SGSP,
- lecturers in SGSP's Erasmus+ programme
- PhD students
- members of the Erasmus+ team of SGSP

Each participant receives a scholarship from Erasmus+ programme. Additionally, from University fundings worker can count on receiving extra fundings to cover costs of the travel to partners University.

To the general goals of realizing mobility, in the context of academic lecturers, under Erasmus+ programme count:

- preparation of didactics materials
- joint programs with partners universities
- strengthen and widen partnership between universities
- preparation and realization of the future scientific and development projects
- boosting qualification skills

Person qualified for travel has to bring before starting procedure agreement entitled: „Staff Mobility for Training – Mobility Agreement” signed directly by the Boss according to professional profile or filed of development.

They will also receive scholarship due to the wages valid in Erasmus+ program for academic year 2022/23, which are dedicated to cover costs of maintenance and accommodation during stay at the partners University. Persons qualified for E+ travel also receive cofunding of costs of the travel.
